## FACULTY ADVISOR/SPONSOR GUIDELINES

A faculty advisor/sponsor is selected (FA) by the chapter to oversee and support the programs set forth by the individual chapter. The faculty advisor is an invaluable asset to the success of any student organization. The duties and rights of the faculty advisor are as follows:

- A. Maintain a good relationship with the students and be truly sincere about the ideals set forth by the national fraternity.
- B. Be willing to use their personal time to attend chapter meetings semi-annually to ensure that the chapter is being properly run.
- C. Serve as a liaison between the chapter and the necessary institutional administration.
- D. Thoroughly understand the risk management or hazing policies of their respective institution and the national fraternity and enforce it properly.
- E. Assist with organizational crises and give honest feedback to members.
- F. Bring experience that younger students may not have.
- G. Support the chapter with commendations and praise as they see fit
- H. Have an understanding spirit of students and should mentor them as an older brother to the entire chapter.
- I. FA's are not voting members of the chapter and are not allowed to enforce any personal agenda on the chapter.
- J. FA's do not have access to chapter funds unless provided by a  $\frac{3}{4}$  majority vote by the chapter.
- K. Chapters may have and are encouraged to select more than one FA
- L. Chapters have the power to remove and replace FA's

Being a faculty advisor should be a respected position and even a sought after one. It is the highest honor that a chapter can provide to anyone who may not necessarily be an initiated member of Phi Boota roota National Percussion Fraternity.
